Talk on the ETP and its impact on businesses including the communications industry

A talk about the Economic Transformation Programme (ETP): Catalyst for Business Growth is scheduled for **Wednesday, 30 March 2011, 4.00pm, Dewan Berjaya 1, Bukit Kiara Equestrian & Country Resort.**

Chris Tan Director, Electronics & Electrical, Economic Transformation Programme, PEMANDU will speak on the key thrusts of the ETP – Focus, Competitiveness, Anchorage of Key Performance Indicators Discipline of Action and Catalytic Effects – its progress to date and what it means for businesses including the communications industry.

Chris joined PEMANDU on 1 October 2010, after serving as the Electronics and Electrical NKEA lab leader leading up to the completion of the Economic Transformation Programme roadmap.

Previously, Chris was Senior Vice President at the Northern Corridor Implementation Authority (NCIA), and General Manager of the Manufacturing Division. The NCIA is the agency responsible for implementing the Northern Corridor Economic Region (NCER) master plan.

Earlier, Chris had served for two decades with Intel Corporation, where he worked in several divisions including manufacturing, supply chain management, system architecture, business process reengineering, and sales and marketing.

He is a graduate of the Australian National University, and is professionally certified in Production and Inventory Management (CPIM) by the American Production and Inventory Control Society (APICS).
